

Course Requirements for Exchange and Visiting Students

Courses at NTUSP are divided into three categories, and each category has its restriction and prerequisites for exchange and visiting students. Please see the course requirements as below:

- A. Pharmacy Foundational Knowledge (Basic Pharmaceutical Science Courses):
 1. Exchange and visiting students can take these courses only when the total number of the course participants is within the limit;
 2. Exchange and visiting students who would like to take “Pharmaceutical Chemistry” or “Pharmacognosy” should take the prerequisite “Organic Chemistry”.

- B. Clinical Pharmacy Courses:
 1. Exchange and visiting students can take these courses only with the instructors’ approval.
 2. Exchange and visiting students should have completed a course in Pharmacology (including Laboratory) for at least 6 credits.

- C. Pharmacy Practice Experiences: Not open to exchange and visiting students.
